Assignment: In groups of 3 or 4 you will choose a recorded song in which you will interpret into a story. Once you have decided on a song, determine a story that can be performed in front of the class without the use of dialogue. You will not be allowed to speak during the performance. The audience will only hear the music and the lyrics. The performance must be between 2-4 minutes, have a beginning, middle, & end, and the story must coincide with the selected song. All performances will be graded as a group, not individually.

(Song and performance must be school appropriate or all points are forfeited and student(s) receives a zero.)

Objective: Student will be able to interpret and perform a complete and coherent story in front of an audience without speaking; using only body movement and facial expressions.
