

Light Up the Music

For this assignment, you will choose **TWO** of your favorite songs. Please choose songs that do not use profane language (we will listen to these songs in class). If there are cuss words in the song, you need to choose a different song. You will receive zero points for any song containing obscene language.

Your songs should contrast each other. For example, if one song is a “feel good” song that energizes you, then the other should be something that calms you down.

Using the online lighting lab, create **THREE** different lighting looks for each song (think beginning, middle, and end). Think about color choices - what colors represent the mood/theme for each song (or each part of the song).

Take a screenshot of each “look” and insert each image into a Google Slides Presentation. Make sure you expand your screenshot to fill up the entire slide so we can see it!

This means you should have **7 TOTAL SLIDES** - 3 for each song, plus a title slide that includes your first and last name, and some kind of picture/image of your choice that relates to lights and/or music. Make your title slide as interesting as possible! Use colors and an interesting font.

You will share your slides with the class. You need to have access to both of your songs on your computer - NOT YOUR PHONE (Spotify, YouTube, downloaded songs, whatever). You will play each song along with your slideshow presentation.
