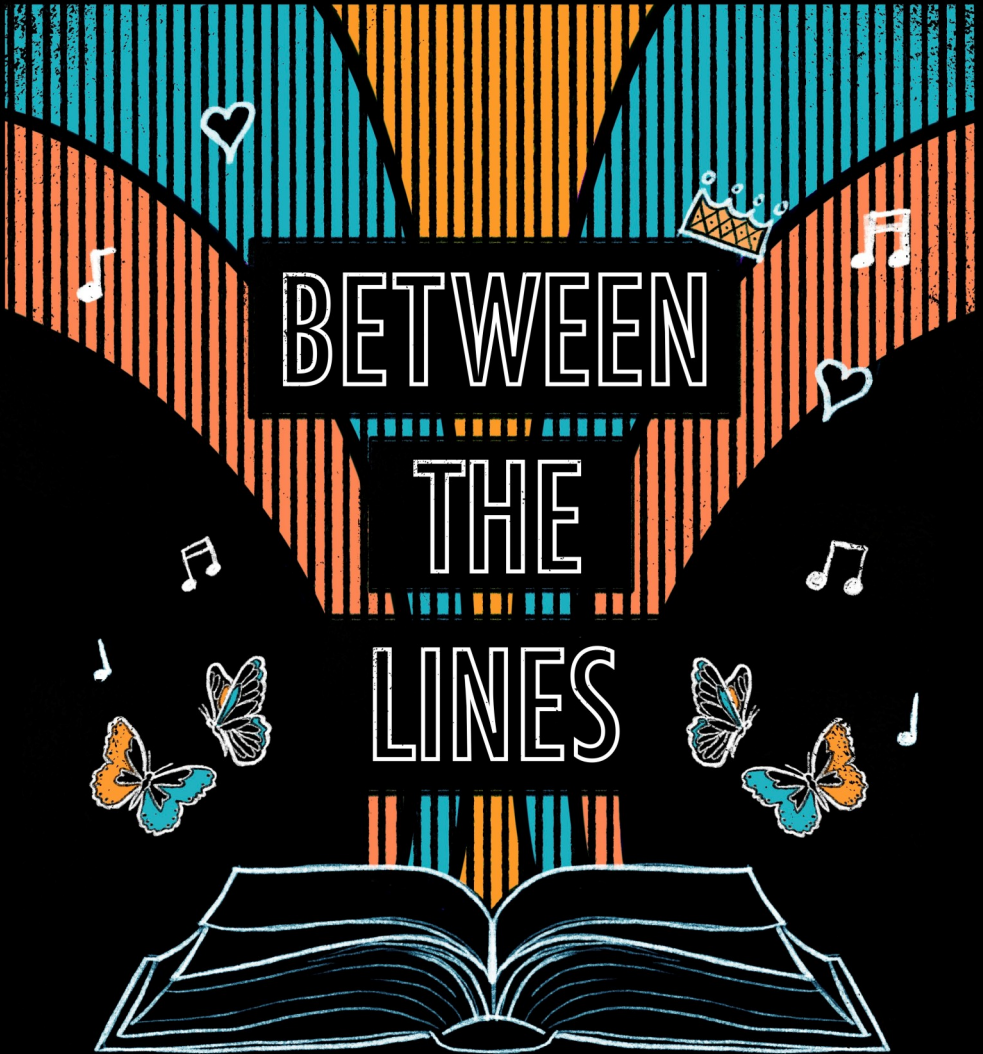

In 2018, OE Theatre started its student designer mentoring program. We decided to allocate more of our budget into hiring guest artists to mentor our students in the design process and production of our mainstage productions. This investment has fulfilled a growing desire for our students to participate in the designing and construction of our largest productions during the year. It has also created a better experience and education for our technical theatre students as there is now more focused teaching in smaller groups. As a result, we have increased our theatre enrollment at Olathe East, and more graduates are now pursuing a Technical Theatre degree at the college level.
